Hazard Identification--Explanation of SIGNAL WORDS

This manual uses SIGNAL WORDS to indicate the likelihood of personal injuries, as well as the probable seriousness of those injuries, if the product is misused in the ways described. Other signal words call attention to uses of the product likely cause property damage.

AWARNING If this product is used improperly or carelessly, the operator and/or bystanders might sustain serious personal injuries or even be killed. ALWAYS use the product properly:

• Failure to read and understand the entire manual before assembling, installing, using or servicing the product <u>constitutes misuse</u>. Read the manual to refresh your understanding of proper use and maintenance procedures.

• DO NOT exceed the maximum rated load.

• Inspect the dolly before each use. Remove the dolly from service if the inspection reveals damage *such as*: 1) cracked welds; 2) corrosion, extreme wear, or other condition that affects the ability of the product to support applied weight; 3) significantly worn or cracked casters; 4) missing chains (1 chain for each of the semicircular brackets). DO NOT use the product until it is restored to normal condition. ONLY use manufacturer-approved replacement parts.

• DO NOT use the dolly to transport any cylinder that does not seat securely in the semicircular brackets.


• DO NOT transport a cylinder without using the bracket chains. Each time the dolly is used to transport a cylinder, wrap the chains without slack around the cylinder. Secure the chains in the latch slots on the opposite side of the brackets.

• When transporting a cylinder up-or-downhill, always remain uphill to the cylinder.


• DO NOT remove or obscure any label. All product labels must be readable and undamaged.


• DO NOT modify the dolly in any way. Unauthorized modifications automatically void the limited warranty (see p. 7) and might make the dolly unsafe to use.



Use Instructions:

- 1. Place the cylinder on the cart. Position the cylinder so that it seats firmly within the (semicircular) cylinder brackets.
- 2. Wrap the chains around the cylinder with no slack.
- 3. Feed the free ends of the chains through the latch openings in the brackets, and seat a link into the vertical slots.




Inspections and Maintenance:

Inspect the dolly periodically (at least every couple of months) to confirm normal condition. If the inspection reveals problems, do not use the dolly until it is restored to normal condition.

- Examine the dolly for cracked welds, metal fatigue, rust, and corrosion that affects the structural integrity of the dolly.
- Inspect the cylinder brackets. Each bracket should be solidly welded to the upright frame.
- Check the hardware that fastens the handle to the frame. The connection should not be loose. Tighten the fasteners if necessary.
- Check the overall structure of the dolly. The frame should be rigid and square.

LIMITED WARRANTY

Vestil Manufacturing Corporation ("Vestil") warrants this product to be free of defects in material and workmanship during the warranty period. *Our warranty obligation is <u>to provide a replacement for a defective original part</u> <i>if the part is covered by the warranty, after we receive a proper request from the warrantee (you) for warranty service.*

Who may request service?

Only a warrantee may request service. You are a warrantee if you purchased the product from Vestil or from an authorized distributor AND Vestil has been fully paid.

What is an "original part"?

An original part is a part <u>used to make the product as shipped</u> to the warrantee.

What is a "proper request"?

A request for warranty service is proper if Vestil receives: 1) a photocopy of the <u>Customer Invoice</u> that displays the shipping date; AND 2) a <u>written request</u> for warranty service including your name and phone number. Send requests by any of the following methods:

In the written request, list the parts believed to be defective and include the address where replacements should be delivered.

What is covered under the warranty?

After Vestil receives your request for warranty service, an authorized representative will contact you to determine whether your claim is covered by the warranty. Before providing warranty service, Vestil may require you to send the entire product, or just the defective part or parts, to its facility in Angola, IN. The warranty covers defects in the following <u>original dynamic components</u>: motors, hydraulic pumps, electronic controllers, switches and cylinders. It also covers defects in <u>original</u> parts that wear under normal usage conditions ("<u>wearing parts</u>"), such as bearings, hoses, wheels, seals, brushes, and batteries.

How long is the warranty period?

The warranty period for original components is <u>90 days</u>. The warranty period begins on the date when Vestil ships the product to the warrantee. If the product was purchased from an authorized distributor, the period begins when the distributor ships the product. Vestil may extend the warranty period for products shipped from authorized distributors by *up to* 30 days to account for shipping time.

If a defective part is covered by the warranty, what will Vestil do to correct the problem?

Vestil will provide an appropriate replacement for any *covered* part. An authorized representative of Vestil will contact you to discuss your claim.

What is not covered by the warranty?

- 1. Labor;
- 2. Freight;
- 3. Occurrence of any of the following, which automatically voids the warranty:
 - Product misuse;
 - Negligent operation or repair;
 - Corrosion or use in corrosive conditions;
 - Inadequate or improper maintenance;
 - Damage sustained during shipping;
 - Accidents involving the product;

• <u>Unauthorized modifications</u>: DO NOT modify the product IN ANY WAY without first receiving written authorization from Vestil. Modification(s) might make the product unsafe to use or might cause excessive and/or abnormal wear.

Do any other warranties apply to the product?

Vestil Manufacturing Corp. makes no other express warranties. All implied warranties are disclaimed to the extent allowed by law. Any implied warranty not disclaimed is limited in scope to the terms of this Limited Warranty.
